

Your privacy is important to us. It is our policy to respect your privacy regarding any information we may collect from you through our app, ChordClub.

We currently use Auth0 for ChordClub's authentication. Please see [their many certifications](#) and website for more information on Auth0. The data you upload to ChordClub is associated only with your Auth0 identifier, so our data persistence is effectively separated from user identity. We seek to minimize personal information we collect. Currently, the only identifying pieces of information we persist is your authentication information (via Auth0) and your username (which you may choose to your needs).

All musical data we collect in the app, we collect by fair and lawful means, with your knowledge and consent. To these ends, we ask you permission before you begin recording audio or upload an image to the app.

We only retain collected information for as long as necessary to provide you with your requested service. What data we store, we'll protect within commercially acceptable means to prevent loss and theft, as well as unauthorized access, disclosure, copying, use or modification.

We don't share any personally identifying information publicly or with third-parties, except when required to by law.

Our app may link to external sites that are not operated by us. Please be aware that we have no control over the content and practices of these sites, and cannot accept responsibility or liability for their respective privacy policies.

You are free to refuse our request for your personal information, with the understanding that we may be unable to provide you with some of your desired services.

Your continued use of our app will be regarded as acceptance of our practices around privacy and personal information. If you have any questions about how we handle user data and personal information, feel free to contact us.
